

Hello

I began mixing batches of soap in 2008, exhausted by not being able to find a product I was happy to use on my own and my daughter's skin!

Why Soap? We all use it, to wash our hands and have a shower but does everyone know what goes into a bar of soap? It's easier to tell you first what I don't use, harsh petrochemicals, foaming agents (SLS's & SLR's), manmade chemical base preservative (parabens), artificial fragrances and colours are all left out. Then what I do use? I select oils that are first pressing, unrefined, organic where possible and beeswax from my own hives. I choose the highest grade raw oils and materials without bleaching agents and refinement and that's it. Nothing else is added! 'A blend of oils to make nothing but soap.'

I am passionately concerned over the amount of Palm oil used in the cosmetic industry, especially soap. I could not find a recipe to make soap without it, so I went about designing my own, taking eight months to perfect the recipe by adding and deducting oils, adjusting percentages.

Then I needed to present the soap to the consumer. What material could I use that has a low impact on the environment? After much deliberation the idea to use Organic fair trade cotton was born and something that could be re-used.

I have strived in all decisions to ensure my soap is truly eco-friendly with consideration to the environmental impact from making, distributing and using the product. It's been great fun, a learning journey and a privilege to meet so many like minded people.

Here are just some of the things they've said...

I am always on the lookout for new products that might work for my skin, and the ingredients list on your soaps looked really good. No Palm Oil

Emma does not add any preservative, foaming agents, artificial colours or fragrances. Wanting to know the exact source of all the ingredients Emma only uses the highest grade quality oils, first pressing, organic, unrefined and her own Beeswax and from local beekeepers.

Emma's Soap does not contain Palm Oil, a crop used for a myriad of purposes, as an ingredient in food products, engine lubricants to a base for cosmetics. Emma discovered that there is no Material Identity Card (MIC) scheme in place to trace the raw material of palm oil from its origins and through all the refining processes; 'it is impossible to know exactly which plantations the oil has originated from'.


Natural swarm, caught, tendered, one hive made two!

All paper and cardboard is carefully chosen to minimize the impact on the environment.

The parchment paper that is used beneath the fabric to wrap the soap is Quilon and

Quilon contains heavy metals such as chromium which are toxic if incinerated and chlorine used in the manufacture of paper is a major pollutant of waterways. The paper, along with the raffia and label can all be safely bio-degraded in the compost heap.

All paper used in the business is FSC approved, recycled, acid-free and carbon neutral. All inks used are vegetable based.

Emma suggests that you can re-use any of the paper products by shredding them soaking them and pressing them into a paper brick which you can then burn on the fire to keep warm with our compliments!



WASTE

Emma tries to minimise all potential waste. Cardboard is reused and recycled. Waste paper is made into paper bricks and then used as fuel. Containers are returned to supplier for refills or recycled through appropriate waste stream.

Each base oil has its own decanting/pouring container to minimise washing up and water waste, when washing of a container is necessary, the base oil (all bio-degradable) is saturated in recycled paper towel which is composted down resulting in fertilizer.

Any soap shavings from the mould removal are re batched into Emma's Laundry Soap. All material is re-used and any off cuts of material are bundled and sold. Raffia ends are collected and used as packaging. Resulting in very little landfill waste.
